2021-2022 Enrollment by the Numbers

- 35: **Early Childhood Center (ECC)**
7 more students than 2020-2021; max capacity 35 (with VA DOE Covid mitigation requirements)
- 253: **Kindergarten – Grade 8**
21 more students than 2020-21 (increase partially due to two-track kindergarten); max capacity ~260 with 2 track kindergarten, ~252 with all one-track grades
- 288: **Total Enrollment for ECC and K-8**
28 more students than 2020-21
