HEALTH FORMS

ECC and Kindergarten students must have a physical examination within 12 months prior to the first day of school and proof of adequate immunization.

Grade school students (grades 1-8) must provide the school with a completed physical examination form and proof of updated immunizations.

APPLICATIONS

- ⇒ Registration for all returning students is due on November 18, 2022. Applications for new siblings are due December 6, 2022.
- ⇒ Applications for **Blessed Sacrament parish families** will be due January 11, 2023. A registered parishioner is one who has completed the proper paperwork at the parish office and who receives church envelopes.
 - Priority is based on longevity of parish membership.
 - Applications can be submitted through a link on our website.
 - Applications received after 4 p.m. on the last day will be on a secondary parish waiting list in the order in which they are received.
- ⇒ Applications for **non-parishioners** (on a first-come, first-served basis) will be due **January 18, 2023.** Catholics who are non-parishioners at Blessed Sacrament will need to provide written proof of current parish registration to be given priority over non-Catholic families.

Application fee of \$35 per new applicant payable by check due upon submission.

All new K-8 and transfer students must have a complete application, and must undergo Assessment Testing prior to final acceptance.

*Upon acceptance, registration fee (also technology fee and workbook fee for grades K-8) as well as first month's tuition for new families must be paid by due date. Prompt payment is required to continue enrollment.

*All tuition, registration fees, or fee payments are non-refundable.

Sibling Preference

To receive a sibling preference, a new registrant for the <u>ECC</u> must have a sibling who is enrolled in either ECC or the grade school for the current year and who will be enrolled for the coming year.

A new registrant for the <u>grade school</u> must have a sibling who is enrolled in the grade school for the current year and who will be enrolled for the coming year. Priority is given to registered parishioners.

EXTENDED DAY PROGRAM FEE SCHEDULE (2022-2023 School Year)

A yearly non-refundable fee of \$35 per new student or \$25 per returning student must be paid when the application for enrollment is submitted.

(Maximum fee of \$75 per year per family.)
